

Centres Competition 2020: Demand Management

Our intention is to make up to five awards through the competition. It is therefore important that we manage demand to give applicants a realistic chance of success and minimise the effort invested in preparing, submitting and reviewing unsuccessful applications.

We have contacted Higher Education research organisations to inform them how many proposals can be submitted by the institution. Your institution will be able to provide you with further information. Unless notified otherwise, independent ROs applying to the competition should assume they can submit one application.

Some existing ESRC Centres will also be entitled to apply to this competition in addition to this institutional allocation. These eligible Centres are listed below. This is not a full list of current ESRC Centres as some are not eligible for the Centres 2020 call. If you have any queries around inclusion in this list, please contact your ESRC Investment Manager. This list does not suggest obligation or expectation that we will receive an application from the Centre. Co-funded Centres should seek advice from their ESRC Investment Manager if considering applying for funding through the Competition.

Any application from an existing Centre will be treated the same as any other application and will not be advantaged or disadvantaged in any way.

Applications to the highlight element of the Centres 2020 call will not be restricted, however we do ask that ROs limit the number of applications to support only those of the highest quality.
